14 And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your God: [it shall be] a **statute** for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

21 And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, [that] it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work [therein: it shall be] a **statute** for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations....

31 Ye shall do no manner of work: [it shall be] a **statute** for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.....

41 And ye shall keep it a feast unto Yahuwah seven days in the year. [It shall be] a **statute** for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month.

25 Years After The Cross**
